Section 1 – Veteran Definition

British Columbia Veteran Licence Plates are available to a person who meets the following Veteran definition:

“Any person who has served or is currently serving in the Canadian Forces, Regular or Reserve, who is trade qualified, is eligible to receive British Columbia Veteran Licence Plates.”

Important: Before completing this application, please read the Completion Information, including General Instructions, Who’s Eligible, and Proof of Service Documents on the reverse side of this form.

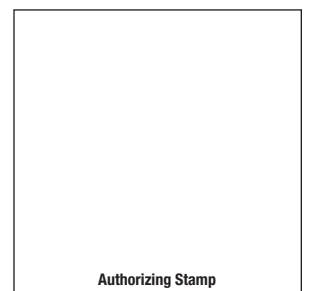

COMPLETION INFORMATION

PLEASE READ PRIOR TO COMPLETING YOUR APPLICATION

1. General Instructions

1. Confirm that you are eligible to apply for a Veteran licence plate – see *Who's Eligible?* below.
2. Complete **all** of the information blanks in Section 2 of the application.
3. Photocopy your proof of service documents – see *Proof of Service Documents* below.
4. Complete a cheque or money order for \$5.00 (non-refundable), payable to the Authorized Service Organization of your choice – see *Authorized Services Organizations* below.
5. Mail the completed application, the photocopy of your service document(s), and the cheque or money order to the Authorized Service Organization you have selected. They will process your application and return all documents to you by mail.
6. Present the original, approved application and your *Owner's Certificate of Insurance and Vehicle Licence* to your Autoplan broker. Your broker will order your Veteran plates and will contact you when the plates have arrived at their office.

2. Who's Eligible?

Members who meet any one of the following are eligible to apply for a Veteran plate.

1. Served in WWII, Korea, Gulf War, or Afghanistan as a member of:
 - the Canadian Armed Forces, or
 - an Allied Force, or
 - the Canadian or Allied Merchant Navy, or
 - the Ferry Command, andwho has been honourably discharged, or who is currently serving.
2. Served as a member of the Canadian Forces, Regular or Reserves, with a trade qualification, who has been honourably discharged, or who is currently serving.
3. Served in UN or NATO Operations as a member of:
 - the Canadian Forces, or
 - a UN or NATO Alliance Force serving in an Operation with a Canadian Force, or
 - the Royal Canadian Mounted Police or Municipal Police, andwho has been honourably discharged, or who is currently serving.
4. Served as a similarly qualified member of a British Commonwealth of Nations Force and has been honourably discharged.

3. Proof of Service Documents

A photocopy of the appropriate proof of service documents must be submitted with your application.
NO OTHER TYPE OF DOCUMENTATION IS ACCEPTABLE.

1. Military Service
 - Discharged Members
 - Discharge Certificate or Certificate of Service, or
 - WWII General Service Badge Certificate, or
 - DND 75 Discharge Identification Card, or
 - Veterans Affairs Health Card, or
 - Library & Archives Canada Record of Service.
 - Currently Serving Members
 - Military Identification Card, and
 - Members Personal Record Résumé (MPRR).
2. RCMP/Municipal Police Service
 - Discharged and Currently Serving Members
 - Certification from the Chief Human Resources Officer, or delegate, of the member's service in a UN or NATO Operation.

4. Authorized Service Organizations
