The Abbotsford Poppy Album

World War II 1939-1945



The Poppy Album highlights many of the home addresses of Abbotsford recruits who were casualties in World War II, with each address marked by a poppy.

Looking at their homes in our community, we are connected to the past through geography. The physical locations link us to life-altering events in the history of our country, and enable us to imagine the world that these families inhabited.

The Poppy Album reminds us that the streets where we walk are layered with meaning, and resonate with the lives of individuals who walked before us. Connecting with the places that these recruits called home, but never saw again, helps us to understand how large events affect the lives of ordinary people.

We invite Abbotsford residents to interact with The Poppy Album. An address on the map may be your own, and you might be interested in learning some of the history of your residence. If you have information that will help us to update the album, please contact The Abbotsford Legion, Branch #15.

This project was the product of painstaking research into local records and newspaper archives by Brian Radant, a University of the Fraser Valley student in the Work Study Program, under the supervision of Dr. Molly Ungar.

Additional contributions were made by Drew Koehn, a summer intern at The Reach Gallery and Museum and a University of the Fraser Valley graduate.


